Agenda Item:

1. Introductions and Apologies:

2. **Research recommendations:**

The GDG split into two groups to discuss potential research recommendations for each of the topic areas. SR and CB will work on the draft recommendations and forward them to the GDG for comment.

4. **Presentation from NICE editor:**

LK gave an introduction to her role as editor. LK discussed the NICE quick reference guide (QRG) and the understanding NICE guidance (UNG) and asked for volunteers from the GDG to assist. Volunteers should contact SR.

5. **Results of update search – Standard principles:**

SR presented the results of the update searches for hand hygiene, sharps and personal protective equipment. The GDG discussed the evidence presented and decided that no evidence was included. SP gave an update to the patient information question and explained that the work was ongoing and the will be presented at the next GDG.

6. **Results of update search – Devices:**

SR presented the results of the update searches for vascular access devices (VADs), long term urinary catheters (LTUCs) and percutaneous endoscopic gastrostomy. The GDG discussed the evidence presented and decided that no evidence was included.

7. Reviewing recommendations and LETRs:

SR presented some outstanding issues regarding draft recommendations the GDG, focussing on the editor's comments on VADs and LTUCs. The full list of recommendations will be reviewed at the next meeting.

8. The next steps:

SR asked the GDG to review the write up chapters and add text where required or make comments to ensure that the chapters read well, focussing on the introductions and linking evidence to recommendations. SR presented the timeline for the guideline and the dates and content of the forthcoming meetings. Last date for GDG comments 6th June.
