1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

2. Consultation feedback - Accuracy of anthropometric measures for measuring health risks associated with central adiposity in adults/CYP

KK introduced Shreya Shukla (SS) and Alexander Allen (AA) who began to take the committee through the multiple stakeholder comments we had received on the draft recommendations that were put out for consultation during April and early May 2022. The morning session focused on themes dealing with children and young people in particular.

The committee were consulted on how best to react and respond to each of these comments and suggest changes to the recommendations where appropriate.

3. Consultation feedback - Accuracy of anthropometric measures for measuring health risks associated with central adiposity in adults/CYP

After a short break SS and AA continued to guide the committee through the comments received from stakeholders and take notes from the committee on how best to adopt suggested changes and/or respond to stakeholder comments.

KK then thanked SS and AA for their work in drafting suggested responses to the comments in preparation for this committee and closed this particular section of the meeting.

4. Consultation feedback - Accuracy of anthropometric measures for measuring health risks associated with central adiposity in adults/CYP

During the afternoon, SS and AA continued to guide the committee through stakeholder feedback, but here focused more on themes impacting adults.
