

# IPG101- Wireless capsule endoscopy for investigation of the small bowel

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

#### **Procedure:**

### OPCS-4 code(s):

U17.7 Wireless capsule endoscopy of digestive tract

**Z27.7 Small intestine** 

**Note:** Where both the small and large intestine have been examined, **Z29.9 Bowel NEC** is assigned in preference to **Z27.7**.

## Diagnosis or health condition:

The ICD-10 code to classify the reason for investigation is assigned.
