Note: An OPCS-4 code from the range **X72-X73** from the National Tariff Chemotherapy Regimens List 2017-18 is assigned, as per the instructions in National Clinical Coding Standards OPCS-4 reference book **PCSX27: Delivery of chemotherapy for neoplasm (X72-X73)**.

Note: Only delivery of chemotherapy codes from categories **X72** and **X73** are required for national reporting purposes. The collection of codes classifying procurement is not required.

Note: It is not possible to classify the 'pressurised aerosolised' aspect of this treatment within OPCS-4.
