

## IP1557 – Vertebral body tethering for idiopathic scoliosis in children and young people

### Diagnosis or health condition:

#### ICD-10 code(s):

**M41.0 Infantile idiopathic scoliosis**

Or

**M41.1 Juvenile idiopathic scoliosis**

Or

**M41.2 Other idiopathic scoliosis**

Please note additional 5<sup>th</sup> character code can be assigned to indicate site of involvement from supplementary subclassification at block M40-M54 Dorsopathies.
