

IP746/3 - Intramuscular diaphragm stimulation for ventilator-dependent chronic respiratory failure caused by high spinal cord injuries

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

A70.1 Implantation of peripheral nerve neurostimulator

Y75.2 Laparoscopic approach to abdominal cavity NEC

Z53.1 Diaphragm

Diagnosis or health condition:

ICD-10 code(s):

J96.1 Chronic respiratory failure

Note: A fifth character must be assigned with **J96.1** to indicate the type of chronic respiratory failure , i.e. 0 Type I, 1 Type II or 9 Unspecified type.

T91.3 Sequelae of injury of spinal cord

Z99.1 Dependence on respirator

Note: A code classifying the subsequent neurological disease/disorder caused by the injury would also be assigned.
