

## IP1877 – Pharyngeal electrical stimulation for neurogenic dysphagia

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

**Procedure:** 

OPCS-4 code(s):

A70.4 Insertion of neurostimulator electrodes adjacent to peripheral nerve

Diagnosis or health condition:

ICD-10 code(s):

R13.X Dysphagia

If the cause of dysphagia is known, e.g. Parkinson's disease, R13.X would be coded in a secondary position to the known cause.
