Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Intervention: Medical termination of pregnancy Comparator: Surgical termination of pregnancy

Outcomes	QALYs

Review questions by scope area	2.12 For women who are having medical termination of pregnancy and plan to use a progestogen-only contraceptive implant or depot injection, does administration of the contraception at the same time as mifepristone influence the efficacy of the termination? AND 3.2 For women who have had medical termination of pregnancy, how soon afterwards is it safe to insert an intrauterine contraceptive device?
Population	Women who have undergone a medical termination of pregnancy
Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Interventions: Immediate contraception (at setting of termination) Comparator: Delayed contraception (at individual's GP)
Perspective	UK NHS + PSS
Outcomes	Incomplete terminations

Review questions by scope area	4.2 What strategies improve the factors that help or hinder the accessibility and sustainability of a safe termination of pregnancy service?
Population	Women receiving a termination of pregnancy
Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Intervention: A reduction in time between initial presentation and termination of pregnancy Comparator: Current time between initial presentation and termination of pregnancy
Perspective	UK NHS + PSS
Outcomes	Reduction in cost from earlier termination of pregnancy
Type of analysis	Cost-effectiveness analysis
Issues to note	This model estimates the potential cost savings from a reduction in time between initial presentation and termination of pregnancy. It does not consider any specific interventions or their related costs and effectiveness.
