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Notes

1. JW welcomed the group to the fourth meeting of this guideline development group (GDG). Apologies were received from Claire Pesterfield (CP).
2. JW asked all the GDG members and other attendees to declare any new interests that they had accrued since GDG 3 and reiterate any interests declared previously that were relevant to the meeting agenda.

3. The minutes from GDG 3 were agreed.
4. HM presented the draft review for the question on carbohydrate counting for type 1 diabetes (the list of excluded studies, the evidence tables, the evidence profiles and the evidence summary). The group had an opportunity discuss the evidence presented.
5. ZB presented the draft review for the question on multiple daily injections vs. mixed insulin for type 1 diabetes (the list of excluded studies, the evidence tables, the evidence profiles and the evidence summary). The group had an opportunity discuss the evidence presented.
6. JK led the group through the process of interpreting the evidence and drafting recommendations for carbohydrate counting and multiple daily injections vs. mixed insulin for type 1 diabetes. Notes were made live on screen.
7. PJ gave a presentation on possible approaches to the health economic analysis being undertaken for the topic of multiple daily injections vs. mixed insulin for type 1 diabetes. GDG members volunteered to help with inputs to economic models.
8. HM presented the draft review protocol for the finger-prick testing vs. continuous glucose monitoring (CGMS) in type 1 diabetes review question. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
9. MM presented the draft review protocol for the urine ketone monitoring vs. blood ketone monitoring to prevent diabetic ketoacidosis (DKA) in type 1 diabetes review question. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
10. MM presented the draft review protocol for the blood glucose targets in type 1 diabetes review question. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
11. MM presented the draft review protocol for HbA_{1c} targets in type 2 diabetes review question. The group then discussed the protocol and notes were made live on screen.
12. The group had an opportunity to ask questions about the NICE implementation briefing paper.
13. MM described next steps.
14. JW raised three items of other business relating to NCC-WCH/GDG participation in the stakeholder consultation on the scope for the coeliac guideline update, email communication and social arrangements for the next two-day meeting and then thanked the participants for attending and closed the meeting.
