1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair welcomed the committee members and attendees to the 11th meeting on multiple obstetric guidelines update. The committee members and attendees introduced themselves.

The Chair informed the committee that no apologies had been received.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting, which included: reviewing evidence, protocols and making recommendations.

2. Confirmation of matter under discussion, and declarations of interest

The Chair confirmed that, for the purpose of managing conflicts of interest, the matters under discussion were multiple obstetric topics including caesarean birth (CB) and Inducing labour (IoL).

The Chair asked everyone to verbally declare any interests that have risen since the last meeting. New interests were declared and noted below.

3. Minutes of last meeting

The Chair asked the committee to confirm the minutes of the last meeting, and the



committee confirmed that no changes were required.

The action and decision log from Guideline committee meeting 10 was reviewed and confirmed by the committee.

4. Morning presentations

The Chair introduced Louise Geneen, Systematic Reviewer, who presented the evidence review for CBQ5: How should women be monitored after receiving intrathecal opioids for caesarean birth?

5. Afternoon presentations

Louise Geneen, Systematic Reviewer, gave a presentation on the evidence review for CBQ3: What are the procedures to prevent and manage hypothermia and shivering in women having a caesarean birth?

The Chair introduced Eva Gonzalez, Systematic Reviewer, who presented the evidence reviews for CBQ1 (short-term outcomes): What are the risks and benefits of caesarean birth compared with planned vaginal birth at term on neonatal and maternal outcomes?

The Chair introduced James Gilbert, Senior Systematic Reviewer, who presented the protocols for:

- IoLQ3: At what gestational age should induction of labour be offered if spontaneous labour does not ensue?
- IoLQ4: How should labour be induced in women with IUFD who have had a previous caesarean birth?

6. Questions and discussions

The committee discussed the evidence for CBQ3 and 5, and drafted recommendations. The committee discussed the evidence for CBQ1 and how to present the benefits and risks in the context of this question.

The committee reviewed previously drafted recommendations in the CB guideline and discussed edits.

The committee discussed and reviewed the protocols for loLQ3 and 4.

7. Any other business

It was agreed during discussions at the meeting that the guideline title will be changed from 'caesarean section' to 'caesarean birth'.

The Chair reminded the committee of the date for the next meeting.
