<b>1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting</b>

**4. Morning presentations**

Katie Webster and Louise Geneen presented the evidence review and network meta-analysis (NMA) results for IoLQ2 & 3: What are the benefits and harms associated with pharmacological and mechanical methods of induction of labour in women who request labour induction?

David Phillippo presented an overview of threshold analysis and how it will be used to help the committee make good recommendations.

**5. Afternoon presentations**

Paul Jacklin presented the health economic model and NMA report for loLQ2 & 3: What are the benefits and harms associated with pharmacological and mechanical methods of induction of labour in women who request labour induction?

Katie Webster presented the draft protocols for:

- CSQ5: How should women be monitored after receiving intrathecal opioids for caesarean section?
- CSQ6: Are opioids safe and effective for pain management after caesarean section?

The committee discussed the evidence, health economic model and NMA results presented for loLQ2&3 and made recommendations.

The committee discussed the protocols for CSQ5 and CSQ6, made some amendments and signed off.
