In response to a consultation comment, the committee included examples of changes in skin colour that could be included in information given to parents and carers on possible signs and symptoms of neonatal infection. The committee considered whether the examples would be applicable to babies of all skin colours and concluded that the examples chosen were applicable to all skin colours.

The recommendations are not expected to have an adverse impact on people with disabilities.
