1.3 Identification of evidence for review questions

Ten searches were conducted between August 2018 and March 2020 for 13 review questions (RQ).

Searches were re-run in July 2020.

Where appropriate, in-house study design filters were used to limit the retrieval to, for example, randomised controlled trials. Details of the study design filters used can be found in section 3. Other filter or search strategies were used where appropriate to limit results.

Searches were limited to those in the English language. Animal studies were removed from results.

2. Review question search strategies

2.1 Search strategy review questions

RQ1.1: Which maternal and fetal risk factors for early-onset neonatal infection should be used to guide management in the baby?

RQ1.2: Which risk factors in the baby (including symptoms and signs) should raise suspicion of early-onset infection?
