### Consideration of consultation responses on review proposal

# Review of TA117 cinacalcet for the treatment of secondary hyperparathyroidism in patients with end-stage renal disease on maintenance dialysis therapy

This guidance was issued in January, 2007 with a review date of December 2009.

#### Background

At the GE meeting on 8 December 2009 it was agreed the review plans for this guidance would be deferred until the completion of the EVOLVE trial. A four-week consultation was conducted with consultees and commentators. The responses are presented below.
