Age as a potential equality issue was raised by 1 stakeholder. However the GDG did not consider that any recommendation disadvantaged elderly groups – in relation to radiofrequency denervation specifically, where this comment was raised, The trials reviewed for radiofrequency denervation did not suggest that increasing age was associated with a poorer response to radiofrequency denervation and as such, the GDG agreed no assumption can be made regards the contribution of age to treatment success or failure.
