1. EK welcomed Max Birchwood, Max Marshall and Rachel Waddingham to the GDG. Apologies were received from Alison Brabban, Tony Morrison and Peter Woodhams.
2. GDG members declared their relevant interests in relation to the psychosis and schizophrenia guideline.
3. TK highlighted the aims of the day, which were to agree on the review questions and to specify which interventions and populations will be covered; low interventions were clarified and key RCTs identified, and as far as possible spot the comparators and predict positive outcomes.
4. The minutes from the previous GDG were reviewed and confirmed.
5. There were no social care or carer concerns declared
6. Nadir Cheema (NC), the new Health Economist for the guideline, presented the introduction to Health Economics and asked the GDG to assist in setting the priorities for economic analysis.
7. Evan Mayo- Wilson (EMW), systematic reviewer until Amina Udechuku returns, presented the review questions.
8. The natural flow of the conversation lead us onto: Data Extraction- Types of outcomes which were presented by EMW.
9. The review protocols, such as population types were discussed by the group.
10. EMW presented the data classification system which the research assistants populate in view of exporting for the meta-analysis.
11. TK reminded GDG members of the importance of attending a HE session.
12. TK presented the Quality Standard set by the Service User Experience guideline which cites the basic markers for care in mental health.
