#### Minutes

- 1. **Introductions and apologies**. The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, and welcomed Ben Doak as new NICE Guidelines Commissioning Manager for the CKD partial update.
- Declarations of Interest. All GDG members were asked to verbally declare any new declarations of interests since GDG 1. Nicholas Palmer declared participation in a round table discussion on 3<sup>rd</sup>
   October on home haemodialysis, sponsored by Baxter (honorarium and hotel accommodation) as well as participation in a conference on 3 December, run by SBK Healthcare, called 'Managing

Improvement in Renal services'. Both were defined as personal pecuniary non-specific interests with the action 'declare and participate'.

Fiona Loud declared the following new interests:

- A fee from the Welsh renal network for training CKD and practice nurses in how to enable selfcare on 28.09.12. Reasonable expenses only paid. Personal pecuniary, non-healthcare industry related.
- Participation in a day's training in healthcare social marketing in September 2012 from Roche Pharmaceuticals. Group event for health charities, event free to attend. Normal travel expenses only paid. Personal non-pecuniary interest.
  - Invitations by the Kidney Alliance for funding for its World Kidney Day 2013 national event and funding for its 2013-2014 review of the National Service Framework. Non-personal pecuniary interest
  - o Participation in 2 events funded by Abbott Healthcare towards the Kidney Health 2032 project (think-tank). Personal non-pecuniary interest.

The action agreed was 'declare and participate' for all the above interests.

Two of the GDG members (Kathryn Griffith and Karen Jenkins) were asked to leave the meeting for the discussion of the protocol for the efficacy and safety of antiplatelet and antithrombotic therapy, for which they both have declared conflicts.

- 3. **Draft working notes and NICE minutes from GDG1.** The draft working notes and NICE minutes from GDG1 were agreed as an accurate report of the meeting and both accepted without changes.
- 4. **Evidence review: Uric acid lowering.** The revised evidence report was presented by CB and the GDG discussed draft recommendations.
- 5. **Draft health economics work plan.** LL presented the draft economics plan that has to be submitted to NICE after the GDG3 meeting in December. The GDG discussed and chose the 2 review areas to be prioritised for health economic analysis.
- 6. **Evidence review: Low protein diet.** CB presented the evidence report and the GDG discussed draft recommendations.
- 7. **Protocols**. SC took the GDG through the commented protocols on Claromentis and the protocols were revised accordingly.
- 8. **Any other business**. Senior reviewer Sharon Swain was welcomed and introduced to the GDG as new senior reviewer on the guideline. A senior medical editor from NICE will give a presentation at the next GDG meeting.
