1 Background

Inadvertent perioperative hypothermia guideline (CG65) was reviewed in 2015 as part of NICE's routine surveillance programme to decide whether the guideline requires updating.

We are answering the following question(s):

- 1. Are warming devices/mechanisms effective in preventing perioperative inadvertent hypothermia in adults in the different phases of perioperative care, specifically comparing classes of active warming device?
- 2. What is the best site for accurately measuring temperature in the different phases of perioperative care?

4 Guideline Update process

The rapid update programme updates discrete parts of published clinical guidelines through a standing committee. Guidelines eligible for a rapid update are those focusing on small and defined areas of the guideline. More information can be found here.
