- DG welcomed the group to the second meeting of this GDG and introduced Steve Wilcox, occupational psychologist. Apologies were received from Annie Bishop and Nicky Thomas.
- 2. All members present declared no new personal specific, personal non-specific, non-personal specific or non-personal non-specific interest in the development of this guideline, except DG who declared a new personal, pecuniary interest; he was recently appointed as a consultant to Ultrasys, to provide advice on computerised CBT.
- 3. The minutes of the last meeting were agreed as a true and accurate account.
- 4. The recruitment of a carer member for the GDG is ongoing.
- 5. Nick Meader explored with the GDG the areas for possible clinical questions, such as: methods of and populations for identification; models of care; access; psychological /psychosocial interventions; pharmacological interventions; interactions and adverse events; managing side effects; inadequate treatment response; atypical depression; therapeutic drug monitoring; adherence and physical health outcomes.
- 6. The GDG discussed the use of unpublished studies.
- 7. SS gave a presentation on the techniques and search strategies used to locate studies systematically.
- 8. NM presented an overview of physical health populations and outcomes, and the prevalence of depression.
- 9. The GDG discussed the difficulties in classifying depression in those with chronic health problems.
- 10. The GDG discussed how the guideline would be structured.
- 11. The GDG decided how the group would be split to form three topic working groups to discuss:
 - service configuration
 - psychology
 - pharmacology
- 12. IM presented an introduction to health economics.
