#### 1. Welcome and apologies, Declarations of interest, project notes of meeting 9

### 2. Health economics – discussion on treatment paper and presentation of new enhanced care model

The health economist gave an overview of the different health economic models. The group discussed the models and suggested amendments to them

3. Prevalence of hypothyroidism and celiac disease – discussion of evidence Review of history taking and physical examination recommendations Drafting recommendations (enclosures C, D, E)

The group were presented the review for hypothyroidism and celiac disease. Following this presentation, the group discussed the evidence and then drafted a recommendation based on the evidence.

The GDG went on to review previous recommendations made for history taking and physical examination and made changes to them.

The group noted that cross-reference will need to be made to other guidelines

## 4. Involving children – feedback from questionnaires and consideration of scope/included questions

The group were given a summary of children's views based on the comments received.

The costing analyst and editorial lead from NICE gave presentations on their involvement with the development process. Volunteers were requested to help develop the various versions of the guideline, to assist with the costing work and to assist with implementation of the guideline.

The group were presented the review for complementary therapies. The group discussed the evidence and then drafted an interpretation of evidence

### 8. Prescribing and generic substitution

The group discussed the issue of pharmacist prescribing and generic substitution. Advice will be sought on this issue
