Definitions:

Stakeholders

Individuals or organisations interested in a topic being evaluated by the Health Tech Programme, and who register to become a stakeholder. External Assessment Group (EAG)

An independent academic group that prepares a systematic review of the clinical and cost effectiveness of the technology.

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An independent academic group commissioned by NICE that prepares a systematic review of the clinical and cost effectiveness of the technology(ies).
