## 1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

The Chair, Joe Fawke, welcomed the Committee members and attendees to the 5<sup>th</sup> Guideline Committee meeting on Neonatal Parenteral Nutrition.

The Chair informed the Committee that apologies had been received. These are noted above.

The Chair outlined the objectives of the meeting.

#### 2. Confirmation of matter under discussion, and declarations of interest

The Chair confirmed that, for the purpose of managing conflicts of interest, the matter under discussion was Neonatal Parenteral Nutrition.

#### 3. Minutes of last meeting

The minutes of the last meeting were reviewed by the Committee and amendments were made to the attendance list. The updated minutes were agreed as a true and



accurate record of the meeting.

#### 4. Morning presentations

Offiong Ani gave a presentation on NGA committee expenses submission, highlighting changes to the submission deadlines in preparation for the end of the financial year.

Patrice Carter presented a protocol for question 5.1 – In babies on parenteral nutrition, what is the optimal frequency of blood sampling for monitoring glucose, calcium, phosphate, potassium and serum triglycerides?

#### 5. Afternoon presentations

Arun Kumar presented the evidence review for question 2.1 – How many kcal/kg/day should be given to preterm and term babies receiving parenteral nutrition?

Patrice Carter presented a protocol for question 7.1 – Are nutrition care teams (pharmacist and dietician) effective and safe in providing parenteral nutrition on preterm and term babies?

The Chair introduced Dr Roger Soll, who presented a protocol for question 3.7 – What is the clinical effectiveness, efficacy and safety of lipid formulations from different sources (for example, soya, fish oil, or mixed sources)?

Patrice Carter presented the evidence review for question 3.12 – What is the effectiveness, efficacy and safety of standardised parenteral nutrition bags compared with individualised bags?

Alex Bates presented a health economic clinical review and preliminary model on question 3.12.

#### 6. Questions and discussions

The Committee revised the recommendations for the questions on IV amino acids, IV carbohydrates, IV lipids and IV iron (3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 3.5, 3.6 and 3.10).

The Committee signed off the rational and impact, and committee discussion of evidence sections of the report on question 3.10 – What is the most effective and safe iron supplementation compared to no iron or different dosage/formulations in preterm and term babies who are receiving parenteral nutrition and neonatal care?

The Committee amended and finalised the wording of question 5.1, finalised the PICO (population, intervention, comparison, outcomes) characteristics and signed off on the protocol.

The Committee discussed the evidence review for question 2.1 and drafted agreed



recommendations.

The Committee finalised the PICO characteristics and signed off protocol 7.1.

The Committee discussed the PICO characteristics and progress of protocol 3.7, being drafted by the Cochrane Neonatal Group.

The evidence review for question 3.12 was discussed by the Committee and recommendations were agreed and drafted.

The Committee discussed the health economic clinical evidence and how this relates to common practice. The outcomes of the preliminary model were also considered.
