1. Welcome and objectives for the meeting

4. Presentation: Resource impact assessment

Ian Mather gave a presentation on NICE's resource impact assessment work programme and products to support guideline implementation.

5. Presentation: reviewing the clinical evidence

Saoussen Ftouh gave a presentation on minimal clinical important difference and the GRADE (grading of recommendations assessment, development and evaluation) approach to assessing quality of evidence.

6. Evidence review

Katherine Jones presented the included studies for the clinical evidence review: what is the clinical and cost effectiveness of bivalirudin as an adjunctive pharmacotherapy in adults with STEMI undergoing primary percutaneous coronary interventions? The committee discussed the characteristics of the included studies and methods of analysis.

This topic will be revisited at the next committee meeting when results of the clinical and cost effectiveness evidence review are available.

7. Draft protocols

The committee discussed and amended the draft protocol for the evidence review on stents.

8. Health economic priority topics

Kate Lovibond gave an overview of selecting topics for original modelling. Topic selection will be followed up at the next committee meeting, or via a survey.
