Eva Gonzalez-Viana, Senior Systematic Reviewer led discussion on review question 1.3: 'What approaches, and interventions are effective to increase uptake of folic acid before and during the first 12 weeks of pregnancy?'

- **2.3** What approaches and interventions are effective to increase uptake of healthy eating advice during pregnancy in line with government advice?
- 4.1 What approaches and interventions are effective to increase uptake of appropriate and timely introduction to solids (complementary feeding)?
- **4.2** What approaches and interventions are effective to promote healthy eating behaviours in children up to 5 years (in line with government advice)?

Eva Gonzalez-Viana, Senior Systematic Reviewer led discussion on review question 2.2: 'What are the most effective, cost-effective and acceptable interventions for helping



women to achieve healthy and appropriate weight gain during pregnancy (for example
dietary interventions, regular weighing, physical activity)?'
