Eva Gonzalez-Viana, Senior Systematic Reviewer, led discussion on agreeing the protocol for draft review question 1.5: 'What approaches, and interventions are effective to increase uptake of vitamin supplements (including Healthy Start vitamins) in line with government advice for pregnant women, breastfeeding women, babies and children up to 5 years?'
