The Chair introduced Alice Navein, Systematic Reviewer, who gave a presentation on:

RQ 5.2 evidence report - What is the effectiveness of interventions and approaches for reducing gambling-related harms for families, friends, and others close to people who gamble?

The committee discussed the evidence and agreed on draft recommendations and research recommendations.
