The Chair introduced Anja Fricke, Systematic Reviewer, who gave a presentation on:

**RQ 8.1 protocol** - What works well and what could be improved in gambling treatment services, including treatments for individuals, family approaches and relapse prevention, from the perspective of practitioners, people who participate or have participated in harmful gambling and their families, friends and others close to them?

The committee discussed these protocols and agreed edits.

Ifigeneia Mavranezouli, Senior Health Economist, provided a health economic update to the committee.
