

HTG145 - Laparoscopic deroofing of simple renal cysts

M04.1 Deroofing of cyst of kidney

Y75.2 Laparoscopic approach to abdominal cavity NEC

or

M10.3 Endoscopic deroofing of multiple cysts of kidney
