

HTG190 Ex-vivo hepatic resection and reimplantation for liver cancer

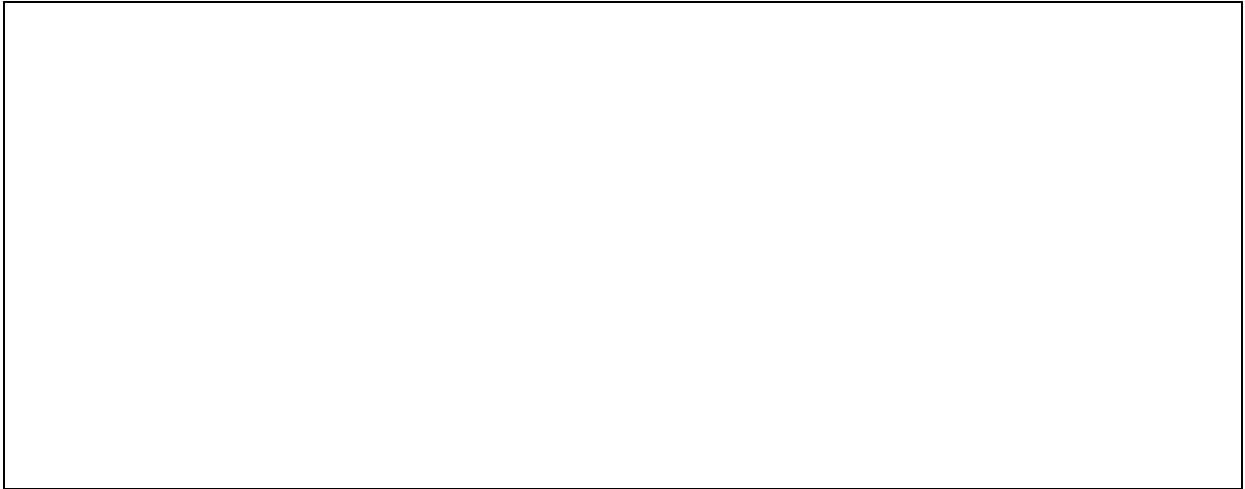
