

HTG29 - Complete cytoreduction for pseudomyxoma peritonei (Sugarbaker technique)

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

Procedure:

OPCS-4 code(s):

This procedure cannot be expressed in the OPCS-4 classification by a single code. The current guidance is to code each organ removed as per normal coding rules, and to combine this with the ICD-10 diagnosis code.

For the intraperitoneal chemotherapy, the following OPCS-4 code is assigned:

T48.2 Introduction of cytotoxic substance into peritoneal cavity

Note: The collection of codes classifying procurement is not required, therefore codes from categories **X70** and **X71** should not be assigned unless there is a local requirement to do so.

ICD-10 code(s):

C78.6 Secondary malignant neoplasm of retroperitoneum and peritoneum
