

HTG319 - Photochemical corneal collagen cross-linkage using riboflavin and ultraviolet A for keratoconus and keratectasia

Note: In the dagger and asterisk system used above, the code that reflects the main condition treated or investigated during the consultant episode must be sequenced in the primary position (see **DGCS.1: Primary diagnosis**).
