

## HTG442 - Infracoccygeal sacropexy using mesh to repair vaginal vault prolapse

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

### **Procedure:**

#### **OPCS-4 code(s):**

**Q54.6 Infracoccygeal hysteropexy**

Plus one of the following codes where the specific type of mesh is known:

**Y28.1 Insertion of synthetic mesh into organ NOC**

Or

**Y28.2 Insertion of biological mesh into organ NOC**

Or

**Y28.3 Insertion of composite mesh into organ NOC**

Or

**Y28.4 Insertion of mesh into organ NOC**

### **Diagnosis or health condition:**

#### **ICD-10 code(s):**

**N81.1 Cystocele**

Or

**N81.2 Incomplete uterovaginal prolapse**

Or

**N81.3 Complete uterovaginal prolapse**

Or

**N81.4 Uterovaginal prolapse, unspecified**

Or

**N81.6 Rectocele**

Or

**N99.3 Prolapse of vaginal vault after hysterectomy**
