Note: the specific site codes for the named artery and vein where stated are assigned in preference to site code **Z89.3 Forearm NEC**

The relevant ICD-10 code for the renal condition for which the patient is receiving dialysis

Plus

Z49.0 Preparatory care for dialysis
(created for future dialysis treatment)

Or

Z99.2 Dependence on renal dialysis
(patient is already receiving dialysis treatment)
