

## **HTG628 Vertebral body tethering for idiopathic scoliosis in children and young people**

**V55.- Levels of spine**

**Y74.2 Thoracoscopic approach to thoracic cavity (if used)**

**Z66.- Vertebra**

### **Diagnosis or health condition:**

#### **ICD-10 code(s):**

**M41.0 Infantile idiopathic scoliosis**

Or

**M41.1 Juvenile idiopathic scoliosis**

Or

**M41.2 Other idiopathic scoliosis**

Please note additional 5<sup>th</sup> character code can be assigned to indicate site of involvement from supplementary subclassification at block M40-M54 Dorsopathies.
