

HTG631 Transcatheter tricuspid valve annuloplasty for tricuspid regurgitation

- K34.2 Annuloplasty of tricuspid valve**
- Y76.8 Other specified minimal access to other body cavity**
- Y53.4 Approach to organ under fluoroscopic control**
- U20.2 Transoesophageal echocardiography**

Diagnosis or health condition:

ICD-10 code(s):

- I07.1 Tricuspid insufficiency**
- Or
- I36.1 Nonrheumatic tricuspid (valve) insufficiency**

Note: Due to the structure of ICD-10 it is possible that a diagnosis of tricuspid regurgitation could be classified elsewhere, as final code selection may be affected by additional information documented within the patient's medical record.
