

## **HTG632 Transcatheter tricuspid valve leaflet repair for tricuspid regurgitation**

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

### **Procedure:**

#### **OPCS-4 code(s):**

**K27.6 Tricuspid valve repair NEC**

**Y76.8 Other specified minimal access to other body cavity** (Based on information that this procedure is performed using femoral or jugular vein approach)

**Y07.2 Clipping of organ NOC**

**Y53.4 Approach to organ under fluoroscopic control**

**U20.2 Transoesophageal echocardiography**

### **Diagnosis or health condition:**

#### **ICD-10 code(s):**

**I07.1 Tricuspid insufficiency**

Or

**I36.1 Nonrheumatic tricuspid (valve) insufficiency**

**Note:** Due to the structure of ICD-10 it is possible that a diagnosis of tricuspid regurgitation could be classified elsewhere, as final code as code selection may be affected by additional information documented within the patient's medical record.
