

## HTG679 Intramuscular diaphragm stimulation for ventilator-dependent chronic respiratory failure caused by high spinal cord injuries

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

### **Procedure:**

#### **OPCS-4 code(s):**

**A70.1** Implantation of peripheral nerve neurostimulator

**Y75.2** Laparoscopic approach to abdominal cavity NEC

**Z53.1** Diaphragm

### **Diagnosis or health condition:**

#### **ICD-10 code(s):**

**J96.1** Chronic respiratory failure

**Note:** A fifth character must be assigned with **J96.1** to indicate the type of chronic respiratory failure, i.e. 0 Type I, 1 Type II or 9 Unspecified type.

**T91.3** Sequelae of injury of spinal cord

**Z99.1** Dependence on respirator

**Note:** A code classifying the subsequent neurological disease/disorder caused by the injury would also be assigned.
