

HTG98 - Foker technique for long-gap oesophageal atresia

Procedure:

OPCS-4 code(s):

G07.3 Correction of congenital atresia of oesophagus

Note: Y70.3 First stage of staged operations NOC or Y71.1 Subsequent stage of staged operations NOC may be added to indicate the stage of the procedure.

Diagnosis or health condition:

ICD-10 code(s):

Q39.0 Atresia of oesophagus without fistula

Or

Q39.1 Atresia of oesophagus with tracheo-oesophageal fistula
