

IPG204 - Laparoscopic distal pancreatectomy

There are specific codes available within OPCS-4 to classify total excision of pancreas, excision of head of pancreas, and partial excision of pancreas; a fourth character code must be selected from the categories below and combined with **Y75.2**.

J55.- Total excision of pancreas

Y75.2 Laparoscopic approach to abdominal cavity NEC

or

J56.- Excision of head of pancreas

Y75.2 Laparoscopic approach to abdominal cavity NEC

or

J57.- Other partial excision of pancreas
