

IPG258 – Intraoperative red blood cell salvage during radical prostatectomy or radical cystectomy

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

Procedure:

OPCS-4 code(s):

There are no OPCS-4 codes which specifically classify a radical prostatectomy or radical cystectomy. Radical procedures are generally not specifically classified in OPCS-4 as these usually refer to a procedure on more than one site which may not be the same each time it is performed.

Within OPCS-4 these procedures would be classified by assigning codes to describe each of the different types of surgery performed or organs removed.

X36.4 Autologous blood salvage

Note: Where the salvaged cells are reinfused either during or after the procedure the following code is also assigned:

X33.7 Autologous transfusion of red blood cells
