

IPG545 - Percutaneous intradiscal radiofrequency treatment of the intervertebral disc nucleus for low back pain

Procedure:

OPCS-4 code(s):

V62.- Primary percutaneous intradiscal radiofrequency thermocoagulation to intervertebral disc

V55.- Levels of spine

Or

V63.- Revisional percutaneous intradiscal radiofrequency thermocoagulation to intervertebral disc

V55.- Levels of spine

Y53.4 Approach to organ under fluoroscopic control

Note: Codes within categories **V62** and **V63** specify the area of the spine where the operation takes place. If the area of spine is not specified, the code **V62.9** Unspecified primary percutaneous intradiscal radiofrequency thermocoagulation to intervertebral disc or **V63.9** Unspecified revisional percutaneous intradiscal radiofrequency thermocoagulation to intervertebral disc is used.

Note: Codes within category **V55.-** are assigned in second place each time a spinal operation is coded. If the levels of spine are not specified, the code **V55.9 Unspecified levels of spine** is used.
