

IPG553 - Microwave ablation for treating liver metastases

SNOMED CT provides clinical terms for entry into the patient record to record clinical information relevant to that encounter; the mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

Procedure and device:

SNOMED CT preferred term (concept ID)

Open microwave ablation of lesion of liver (709020001)

or

Laparoscopic microwave ablation of lesion of liver (448540000)

or

Percutaneous microwave ablation of lesion of liver (609232008)

OPCS-4 codes:

J03.3 Thermal ablation of single lesion of liver

Or

J03.4 Thermal ablation of multiple lesions of liver

Plus

Y13.7 Microwave destruction of lesion of organ NOC

If performed laparoscopically:

J08.3 Endoscopic microwave ablation of lesion of liver using laparoscope

If performed percutaneously:

J12.7 Percutaneous microwave ablation of lesion of liver

Y53.- Approach to organ under image control OR Y68.- Other approach to organ under image control if image control is used
