

IP1746 Permanent His-bundle pacemaker implantation for treatment of heart failure

K60.1 Implantation of intravenous cardiac pacemaker system NEC

Plus

Y53.- Approach to organ under imaging control

Diagnosis or health condition:

ICD-10 code(s):

150.- Heart failure

Note: Due to the structure of ICD-10, certain types of heart failure are excluded from category **I50.- Heart failure**. Therefore, this category may not be appropriate to all situations as code selection may be influenced by additional information documented within the patient medical record.
