

IP1070/2 – Transapical transcatheter mitral valve-in-valve implantation for a failed surgically implanted mitral valve bioprosthesis

The mandated classifications (OPCS-4 or ICD-10) provide a method to collect and aggregate data to allow accurate and consistent data analysis.

OPCS-4 code(s):

K25.2 Xenograft replacement of mitral valve

Y49.4 Transapical approach to heart

Y53.- Approach to organ under image control or Y68.- Other approach to organ under image control

Note: Four-character code assignment will be based on the type of imaging used. Multiple codes from **Y53** and **Y68** may be assigned in instances where different types of image control are used together.

Note: **U20.2 Transoesophageal echocardiography** is also assigned where transoesophageal echocardiography (TOE) is performed.
