





Having failed a swallowing test prior to the procedure I passed it after the procedure and have no swallowing problems at present.

Until it worked i was unable to drink or eat anything. After the first round i was able to start on puree food and the second round straight to full solid and liquid. As i was in hospital it wasn't too bad as i was in ther for other recovery, but it was one of the last pieces of the puzzle in my recovery so felt amazing to have it work. The procedure was fast and painless so no stresses there

It was amazing. Prior to the procedure I was fed by a peg tube which was removed. I couldn't eat or drink which naturally hugely affects your social life. It prevented me from swimming and was embarrassing when wearing certain attire. I felt mentally quite low. The cost to the NHS was huge - expensive liquid feed having to be produced and delivered not to mention the pump I was given and all the nursing care and back up to keep it going. The procedure eliminated all that in 6 days! I lost my confidence prior to the procedure. My sleep was hugely interrupted due to the pump noise and having to change the bottle in the middle of the night. My wife didn't sleep too well. I felt like an invalid. It's absolutely brilliant and I feel like I've got my life back. I was starting to give up on my future. Now I'm golfing again and mixing socially. I can work again part time and I can't stress how massively the procedure has given me my life back mentally physically and emotionally. My friends and family are totally different towards me now as I'm my old self again. Than you Leanne Nicholson.

The procedure improved my swallow that I am now able to consume pureed food (level 4) and slightly thickened liquids (level 1). Before the procedure I was nil to mouth and was not able to consume food or liquids safely. Without the procedure I may not be able to leave hospital today. The doctors wanted to insert a PEG tube into my stomach, something I was not thrilled at the thought of. Thanks to the procedure and my speech therapist I am much happier that I can now consume food and drink of the appropriate levels independently. I am able to leave hospital without a PEG tube and that is an incredible feeling. I have used a NG feeding tube since my surgery (5 weeks ago) to have had this feeding tube removed yesterday was an incredible boost in my self-esteem and I feel much better without it as the Bolus liquids were making me feel sick each time they put them through my feeding tube. I am very grateful to have had this treatment and have it help restore my swallowing function to a safe level.

Procedure probably restored normal swallowing. It is impossible to say if swallowing would at some point returned to normal without the procedure.

The procedure is only mildly uncomfortable. The results could get you fully eating and drinking within days instead of months of training. three 10 minute procedures each day could fully fix the issues with swallowing so it as close to a miracle cure that you can get. I had 2 courses as it hadn't fully worked the first time, but i was more prepared for the second time, and to push myself.

It's radically changed my life. A slight discomfort when undergoing the procedure but worth it compared to the advantages.

To try as there is nothing to lose.

It is 10 minutes of your day, it might be uncomfortable but it is absolutely worth it.
