- 3. No new declarations of interest were made.
- 4. JMcB went through her presentation on the NICE guideline publications.
- 5. The NICE guideline was reviewed recommendation by recommendation, continuing on from yesterday's GDG with:
 - The use of restrictive interventions (rapid tranquillisation, seclusion)
 - Post incident review (working with service users)
 - Interface between mental health services and the police
- 6. Modifications for different populations and different settings were discussed, including:
 - Children and young people (restraint, seclusion, rapid tranquillisation)
 - Emergency departments
