- 6. JP provided an introduction to NICE digital pathways and sought volunteers from the committee to support this version of the Pancreatitis guideline.
- 7. NH from the NIHR joined by teleconference and delivered a presentation on Research Recommendations and offered feedback on the committee's draft recommendations for research.
- 8. The Chair guided group discussions on the prioritisation of Research Recommendations. Committee members volunteered to support draft work on this item and agreed on the top 5 areas for research for the guideline.
- 9. The Chair, Guideline Lead and Medical editor led group discussions on draft recommendations for the guideline.
- 10. The Guideline Lead highlighted key submission dates for the Committee's information.
