- 6. Margherita Fanos delivered a presentation on the diagnosis of chronic pancreatitis, evidence review. The committee discussed the evidence.
- 7. Lefteris Floros updated the committee on the health economic plan and led the group's discussions on the top priorities for the guideline.
- 8. Toluwa Akindele-Ajani and Margherita Fanos presented the draft protocols for the following topics which the committee discussed and made amendments:
 - a. Assessing aetiology chronic pancreatitis
 - b. Biliary obstruction (Dr. Manu Nayar stepped out of the room during discussions on this topic due to existing conflicts)
 - c. Pain (duct obstruction, pseudocysts and small duct disease)
