Yes. Stakeholders raised the issue of 'people with autism' and as a result the committee have added these to the list of groups at high suicide risk in the definition of the guideline.

Stakeholders also raised the issue that in prisons the transgender population was identified as a particularly vulnerable group even amongst the high risk groups of people in prison. The committee however noted that the definition of those at high suicide risk already includes people in the LGBT community.

No changes to the recommendations were made.
