Review question by scope area	What interventions, tools and approaches are effective and cost effective in supporting advance planning for decision-making for people who may lack mental capacity?
Population	Older people in their last year of life
Interventions and comparators considered for inclusion	Intervention: People are offered advance care planning Comparator: Standard care (people are not offered advance care planning)
Perspective	NHS and Personal Social Services (PSS)
Outcomes	Cost per quality-adjusted life year (QALY) from the perspective of the carer
Type of analysis	Cost-utility analysis (decision tree)
Issues to note	This model included health-related quality of life of carers as this was supported by more robust evidence.
	No subgroup analysis could be carried out due to lack of data; it is likely that certain groups would benefit differently.
